Europa Cup - Slopestyle

April 2nd – 05th 2025 Trysil, Norway

Trysil IL, Skistar Trysil and the Norwegian Ski Federation are pleased to invite all freeski nations to attend the Europa Cup Slopestyle to be held in Trysil, Norway on April 2^{nd} to 5^{th} 2025.

Rules

- The Norwegian Ski Association and the organizing committee are organizing an international Europa Cup Freestyle competition, part of the 2025 FIS Freeski Europa Cup Circuit and one FIS Event
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing
- These competitions are Slopestyle Event for both men and women
- These competitions follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The organizing committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather, number of competitors or the decision of the competition jury

Entries

The entries for this event must be done on the FIS Online Entry system (Member section) before March 23rd, 2025.

10 points FIS required in either Big Air or Slopestyle to compete in Europa Cup.

Registration and means of payment

The Race Office is located at **Radisson Blu Resort Trysil**, Hotellvegen 1, 2420 Trysil. Team Registration will take place on:

• April 02nd from 16:00 to 18:00 and 19:00 to 20:00.

All fees must be paid upon registration in EUR or NOK with cash or card. Cheques and traveler's cheques will not be accepted.

Price:

- 50 € athlete competition
- Deposit: 20 € / 200 NOK (in cash) per bib

Please collect all bib numbers and all riders and coaches/staff tickets for the whole nation by one team manager. Each Nations Team Captain will be responsible to return the bibs to the official at the end of the training or competition. Missing bibs will be charged with 20 € per bib.

Quotas

Each nation is entitled to a basic quota of 18 (max. 12 per gender). The Hosting nation is entitled to an additional quota per event 16 (max. 10 per gender).

• Participant limit: 75 men + women

If the competition is not fully booked, we will accept additional athletes above the quota.

Lift tickets

Lift tickets can be purchased digitally (www.skistar.com/en/) with a discount code. The discount code will be distributed prior to the competition.

Accommodations

Each National Ski Association must reserve its own accommodation. Please note that our event will take place during a busy period, so we recommend all the teams to check the accommodation availability as soon as possible.

Team Captains Meeting

The first Team Captains Meeting will be held in:

- April 2nd at 18:00 and then every evening at 18:00

The Team Captains Meeting is obligatory for all nations and teams.

Bibs and helmets

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib.

Liability

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee, Skistar Trysil, Trysil IL, the Norwegian Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible to any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.

Accident Insurance & Protocol

Every competitor must be medically insured in her/his own. The Organizing Committee, Skistar Trysil, Trysil IL, the FIS, and the Norwegian Ski Association declines any responsibility for accidents, damages equipment during the training and competitions.

In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital.
