Preliminary entries 19.06.2024 Final entries by name 06.08.2024 To be eligible for participation all the athletes must have a valid FIS Code. Information regarding ski bindings (SNS Pilot or NNN) must be indicated for each athlete in the preliminary entry.

Visa Support and arrival to Kazakhstan

Organizing Committee is ready to provide Visa support to teams and officials. Citizens of most European countries (+ USA, China, Japan and many others) do not need a visa to visit Kazakhstan. Transportation

Nursultan Nazarbayev International Airport is 240 km away from National Ski Center (Schuchinsk), which is about 3-hour drive. OC provides **one free-of-charge transfer for each team** upon arrival and departure (airport-venue-airport). Airport pick-ups will be provided by request. We kindly ask to specify the date and time of your arrival.






National Ski Center



Accommodation

The hotel is located directly at the venue.

Price for **full board** accommodation is 35,000 KZT (~75 €) per person in double room.

OC provides free full board accommodation for 50 team members. This includes night from one night before the first official training to the night after the last competition. The 50 places will be divided between the teams in accordance to the last season national Rol WC ranking.

If total quota of 50 places is not fully filled until June 19, then in 2nd round remaining places will be filled accordingly to athletes FIS points and/or granted to the developing nations.

Training camp can also be organized before the event.





Insurance

All participants must have an insurance coverage, according to article 212.3 of the current ICR. The LOC is not liable for any kind of accidents, injury, damages, or lost property.

- Juniors must be 2005 2009 years of birth. Competitor must have reached his 16th birthday before the end of the calendar year. Seniors are from 2004 and older.

- 200m Sprint Finals will be organized starting with 1/4 finals with top 16 from qualification and with 2 athletes in a heat.
